

Study 1 Supplementary Results

Figure S2. Study 1 uncounted ballots marginal means plot: Interaction probe of perceived legitimacy according to number of uncounted ballots and political affiliation



Mean and 95% confidence intervals are displayed for the vignette describing uncounted ballots. Higher scores indicate greater perceived illegitimacy of the election winner (lower scores indicate greater perceived legitimacy). Blue (solid) and red (dashed) lines refer to those who reported intending to vote for Biden and Trump, respectively, in the 2020 presidential election. 'Swing' and 'no swing' refer to the conditions where participants are told the number of uncounted ballots are enough, and are not enough, respectively, to change the election result. The delta between Democrats and Republicans for Obama are 1.864 (95% CI: 1.447, 2.282), $t=8.77$, $p<.001$ for Biden and 0.986 (95% CI: 0.539, 1.432), $t=4.34$, $p<.001$ for Trump.
